Essential Skills in the Smarter Balanced Era

Tuesday, October 21, 2014 ~ 9 a.m.—4 p.m.

This workshop will provide participants with an in-depth training and calibration to the Official Mathematics Scoring Guide including scoring student work samples to meet the Essential Skills requirement. Discussion will focus on the Essential Skills requirement and the procedures for work sample administration. Participants will apply the new Essential Skills work sample guidance template to develop an Essential Skills work sample. The workshop will also focus on the content and format of the Mathematics grades 3-8 and high school Smarter Balanced performance tasks and constructed response item types.

Participants will use Smarter Balanced rubrics to score sample student responses. Emphasis will be placed on how teachers can structure activities during regular classroom instruction to promote student confidence and success. Participants are encouraged to bring a high school math textbook, calculator and a laptop.

First part of the day (2-3 hours): Focus will be on Smarter Balanced Assessment and is appropriate for grades 3-8 and high school.

2nd part of the day: Focus will be on Work Samples for Essential Skills. Focus will be at the high school level, but the session is open to all participants.
